



Memorial Recognitions

Third Edition

With the renovation of one church and the construction of another, certain opportunities have arisen for memorial recognitions. It is a long standing tradition of the Catholic Church to attach a specific commemoration to items within a church. This serves to raise funds for our project, while at the same time providing the faithful with a dignified and lasting way to remember someone who has passed.

This catalog will explain the norms, availability, and donation amount associated with memorial recognitions at both churches within our parish.

The items that are listed in this catalog constitute what was available at the time of printing.

Memorial recognitions will not appear upon the item that they are associated with, rather, they will be noted in a dignified permanent public display within the church building. For example, a placard for a memorial recognition would read as follows: "*Tabernacle- In Memory of Joan Williams by Bob & Karen Williams.*"

All furnishings, fixtures, and articles will be selected, purchased, and installed by Fr. Randy, in cooperation with established advisory committees. Donors may be presented with information about the item associated with their gift, but they will not be part of the selection process.

You will receive a commemorative 8x10 framed photo of the item you donate toward, either in its permanent setting or in use by Fr. Randy, with a simple placard referencing your memorial recognition at the bottom.

St. Mary

1. Altar of Repose

We are switching from an in-wall tabernacle to one that will sit on an altar, thus, we needed to purchase an altar of repose. This altar matches the style and wood color of the pews and presiders's chairs. *\$3,000*

3. Stations of the Cross

The stations of the cross have never been a focal point in the main church. However, with the new renovations, we are purchasing a beautiful bronze set of stations that will be hung around the church. *\$5,000*

4. Altar & Processional Candles Set

With the renovations we are taking the opportunity to switch to using real wax candles. Additionally, during the celebration of solemnities, we will be using four candles on the altar. The six new candles will be from a matching set. *\$3,000*

5. Pascal Candle Stand

The Easter candle will be visible year round. It will be displayed in the sanctuary during the Easter season and in front of the baptismal font the rest of the year. This stand will match the style of the other candle holders. *\$2,000*

6. Processional Cross

We have purchased a processional cross that matches the look and dignity of the altar and processional candles. As a matter of fact, all of our sanctuary items share common elements that will create a visual unity. *\$2,500*

7. Incensor, Boat, & Stand

Incense is used at high Masses, Eucharistic Adoration, and Funerals. This new set matches the dignity of other sanctuary items. *\$1,200*

8. Cope & Humeral Veil

This is a very beautiful white cape with blue and purple floral accents, with a matching veil. The center of the hood has an elegant image of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This vestment is used by the priest, especially during Eucharistic Adoration, but can also be worn when the priest or deacon presides at liturgical rites outside of the Mass. **\$2,500**

9. Presiders's Chairs Set

The chairs that are used by the priest and deacon are being replaced in order to match the style and dignity of the new pews. **\$3,500**

10. Sanctuary Lamp

Next to the tabernacle, upon the altar of repose, there will be a lamp with a candle burning in it to signify the presence of the Body of Christ within the tabernacle. This new lamp will match the style and dignity of the other candle stands. **\$1,200**

11. Sacred Oils Cabinet (Ambry) & Cruets

Near the baptismal font, a new cabinet will be constructed that will house the sacred oils used in the sacraments. The cabinet and the cruets will fit with the dignity of the sacred oils. **\$2,000**

12. Eucharistic Vessels Set

The principal chalice is being re-plated in silver with a gold interior cup. Three new silver & gold ciborium (bowls for the hosts) will be purchased. **\$3,000**

13. Individual Pews

All of the pews in the main church and balcony are being replaced with custom built pews. There will be 40 pews, we will accept a donation for each pew. **\$600**

Our Lady of Peace

Artist Collection-

We have hired a Colorado artist to craft the liturgical furniture for the new church, i.e., Main Altar*, Altar of Repose, Ambo (Lectern)*, Presiders's Chairs, Baptismal Font*, Principal Crucifix*, and credence table. Each item will have its own unique characteristics while still looking like a set.

14. Altar of Repose

This altar will reside in the back of the sanctuary in its own alcove. The tabernacle and sanctuary lamp will sit upon it. Inscribed in the top front of the altar will be the Latin phrase "Ecce Tabernaculum Dei," which means, "Behold, the dwelling of God," from Rev. 21:3. Centered on the altar will be the Eucharistic symbol of a pelican feeding her young. **6,000**

15. Presiders's Chairs Set

To the side of the main altar there will be three chairs, with the center chair having greater stature. The fabric on the chairs will match the other chairs used in the church. **\$4,000**

Other Items

17. Altar & Processional Candles Set

With the construction we are taking the opportunity to switch to using real wax candles. Additionally, during the celebration of solemnities, we will be using four candles on the altar. The six new candles will be from a matching set. **\$3,000**

18. Incensor, Boat, & Stand

Incense is used at high Masses, Eucharistic Adoration, and Funerals. This new set matches the dignity of other sanctuary items. **\$1,200**

19. Penitential Cope & Humeral Veil

This is a very beautiful purple cope and matching veil. This special vestment is used by the priests and deacons during the seasons of Advent and Lent. **\$2,500**

20. Processional Cross

We have purchased a processional cross that matches the look and dignity of the altar and processional candles. As a matter of fact, all of our sanctuary items share common elements that will create a visual unity. **\$2,500**

21. Pascal Candle Stand

The Easter candle will be visible year round. It will be displayed in the sanctuary during the Easter season and in front of the baptismal font the rest of the year. This stand will match the style of the other candle holders. **\$2,000**

22. Sanctuary Lamp (Main Church)

Next to the tabernacle, upon the altar of repose, there will be a lamp with a candle burning in it to signify the presence of the Body of Christ within the tabernacle. This new lamp will match the style and dignity of the other candle stands. **\$1,200**

23. Sacred Oils Cabinet (Ambry) & Cruets

Near the baptismal font, a new cabinet will be constructed that will house the sacred oils used in the sacraments. The cabinet and the cruets will fit with the dignity of the sacred oils. **\$2,000**

24. Tabernacle (Daily Mass Chapel)

This tabernacle will sit upon a triangular shelf in the corner of the daily Mass chapel, behind the altar. **\$8,000**

25. Sanctuary Lamp (Daily Mass Chapel)

A lamp with a candle burning in it to signify the presence of the Body of Christ within the tabernacle. **\$1,000**

26. Statue of Mary

This beautiful statue of Mary will be mounted to the wall to the upper left of the main altar. This is a hand carved statue from Italy that portrays a young Mary holding a dove against her chest. **\$10,000**

28. Statue of Joseph

This statue of Joseph will be the same size, material, and coloring of the Mary statue. It will depict Joseph the Carpenter. **\$10,000**

29. Church Bells

The striking new bell tower would not be complete without bells. There is room for three bells. All of these will be rung by electric powered hammers. We have not determined the size or vendor for the bells. *Please Call*

30. Monstrance & Luna Case

This beautiful monstrance resembles a snowflake with the Eucharist at the center. Additionally, a case for the luna will make the transfer and storage of the Eucharist more secure. **\$3,000**

31. Individual Pews

There will be 25 pews; we will accept a donation for each pew. **\$600**

All items are in a variety of different stages/locations:

- Under construction
- Not yet identified or purchased
- Purchased and in transit
- Being repaired/refurbished
- In storage
